Referee who exhibits:

- humble confidence
- control of game
- communicates well with players and coaches
- appropriate use of whistle
- interest in the game
- uniform (shirt tucked in, correct uniform, socks pulled up, badge)
- attends pre-season meetings
- doesn't turn-back games regularly or no-show's assignments
- on time for work
- attend ref. meetings.

“Boys/Girls Rec Coach of the Year” and “competitive coach of the year” | Nominated by coaches, commissioners, parents | Below U10 boys and girls | Above U11 Boys and girls | Field 1st pick

Coach who exhibits:

- upholds the mission of CYSA (state mission)
- follows 50% playing rule
- no complaints from parents/fellow coaches/ referees
- follows the 6-pt. differential policy
- exhibits sportsmanship at all times
- encourages ALL players on the field
- gets along with fellow coaches
- exhibits knowledge of the game and continuing to learn the game
- attends coaches meetings

“Referees Choice”

- referees choose their favorite coach/team to referee for

“Volunteer of the Year” | 10 hrs.

- can be team manager, assistant coach, assistant marshal

“Board Member of the Year” | Nominated by the board
